Let's Clarify Rabbit Animal Projects



REMEMBER: YOU MUST TAKE BREEDING RABBITS #225 TO TAKE MARKETS RABBITS #226. (That means you must complete a breeding rabbit project and show at the county fair junior rabbit show, to show and sell a meat pen or single fryer at the auction).

Also to be eligible for the special \$20.00 award for a doe and litter, the project must be an "A" grade. This means the litter must the correct number of animals, correct age, and no babies added that are not a part of that original litter. Also the judge might request you to present the doe and litter on the show table instead of judging in the cage.

Project Books: There are 2 options for your animal project books. #1 purchase a new book for \$2.00 at the club meeting. #2 download the project book.

Rabbit Cloverbud project books are for free and can be picked up at our meetings.

Do not sign up for the pet rabbit project, we do: show (breeding) rabbits and market rabbits.

Animal (rabbit) project books are ready to be picked up at club meetings. They are \$2.00 each or you can print them from the Van Wert 4-H web site.
